KS2 results comparison July 2017 – July 2018:

Pupils at age related expectations (ARE)	67%	73%	+6%	65%	75%	+10%	67%	71%	+4%

The 2018 results were an improvement from 2017 in all areas except in the proportion of pupils achieving GD in maths.

Pupils at greater depth (GD)	31%	28%	+3%	19%	20%	+1%	17%	24%	-7%

Compared to all schools nationally, pupils at Christ the Sower Ecumenical School achieved age-related results in line with the national average in all subjects except maths where the overall results were slightly below at both ARE and GD.

Pupils achieving the age-related expectations in reading, writing and maths combined was **54%** which is below the 2018 national of **64%**.

Christ the Sower Ecumenical School Progress from KS1-2 July 2018:

Progress for Year 6 pupils is calculated by comparing scaled scores from their end of Year 2 data (taken in 2014) with the scaled scores from their Year 6 test and teacher assessment data (2018). Expected progress would be 0.0, not enough progress would be a value less than 0.0 and children making more than expected progress would be a positive value.
