2. Mr Miles needs 4 groups of 9 for his school golf tournament. How many children does he need to take?
3. There are 5 carriages on a train. Each carriage has 10 passengers. How many people are on the train?
4. What is the product of 3 and 8?
5. Beth has 4 chocolate bars. Each bar has 4 squares of chocolate. How many squares does she have?
6. How many wheels would 7 cars have?
7. Laaibah's hair grows 2cm a month. How long will it grow over 7 months?
8. A café bakes cupcakes in batches of 6. On Saturday they bake 5 batches. How many cupcakes do they make?
9. A triangle has sides of 5cm. What is the perimeter of the triangle?
10. If 6 taxis arrive at a party at once and each taxi has 4 people in, how many people arrive at the party together?
