**Re: Accessing the School Website for 'Home Learning during school closures.**

From Monday, each day we will post new activities for children up on our website. We will aim to post a piece of Maths, English and one other subject for each year group. The idea is that the children would complete these on a daily basis using either worksheets that are online or the books that have been provided.

If children would like to do more, then they can add book reviews, short stories, letters or other pieces of writing to what is in their workbook. Any additional research that they choose to carry out could also go there. Learning the multiplication tables is also a suggested additional activity. Any positive feedback or support that you give your child will help them with their future learning.

You need to go to:

- The 'Learning' tab
- Scroll down to Classes
- Click on classes
- Scroll down to click the relevant year group
- Click on the year group
- Click on the day e.g. Day 1

If you visit the section called Children, click on that and then scroll down to Learning Links there are additional resources and activities stored there.

You may need to accept cookies as you go through the website.

As with all homework, the intention is that your child learns and enjoys. If your child become distressed, then leave it and come back to it later. The homework should be kept and valued but will not be returned to school for marking.

These are unusual and difficult times for everyone, but we hope that some positives might be more family time and a chance to discover new interests together. Cooking, board games, on-line fitness programmes and the wealth of resources, increasingly becoming available, are all good ways to enjoy the time with your children and which will develop their learning.
