It is important that Home Learning books are sent in weekly to ensure your child has an opportunity to complete it in time. Spring term is the time for us to drive their learning to prepare them for their final term in Foundation and to make sure that we take every learning opportunity. Remember to share books with your child to develop a love for reading. If you have any questions or would like to discuss anything please feel free to approach one of the adults on the gate and they will happy to help.
