

## Rosehip

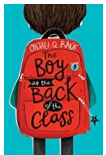

In our other curriculum areas we have lots of other exciting learning and activities to look forward to.

### English

Our English units will take inspiration from key texts this term.



For the first half term we will be looking at the book *The Boy at the Back of the Class* by Onjali Q. Raúf and we will be looking at persuasive writing.



After half term, we will look at writing to entertain and narratives inspired by our text *The Great Chocoplot* by Chris Callaghan.

### Home Learning

We ask all children to complete the following tasks each week:

- **Reading** - Children should aim to read for five minutes every day and log this in their reading diaries. Twice a week, children should complete a longer response to their reading.
- **Times tables** - Children should complete their 5 weekly garage games on Times Table Rockstars and practice their Times Tables weekly on Soundcheck.
- **My Maths** - Children should complete all assigned tasks weekly on My Maths which link to our weekly learning.
- **Spellings** - Children will receive new spelling lists on a Friday to take home and learn. These will be tested on the following Friday.
- **Reading eggs** - Each child should complete the assigned task on Reading eggs weekly—this could be either a reading comprehension or a story book.

In PSHE this half term we will be looking at Health and Wellbeing.

### Religious Education

The overarching key question for the first half term is: Did Jesus really do miracles? In Autumn 2, we are focusing on the question: Does prayer change things?

In Summer 1, we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will learn about different animal groups and how they can be classified.

In Summer 2, we will be learning about sound and how we hear.
