The disco is taking place on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> February – for more information, please see the attached poster.


### In school this week...

EYFS	Amelia Earhart	First woman to fly across the Atlantic Ocean.	
Pumpkin	Emmeline Pankhurst	Political activist who helped women win the right to vote.	
Acorn	Ada Lovelace	Wrote the first computer program	
Mustard	Rosalind Franklin	Her work was central to our understanding of DNA, RNA and viruses.	
Rosehip	Elizabeth Fry	English prison reformer, social reformer, philanthropist and Quaker.	
Catkin	Jane Addams	Pioneer for social change.	
Barley	Chien Shiung-Wu	Worked as senior scientist on the Manhattan Project and helped to separate uranium.	
Wheat	<u>Madam CJ Walker</u>	Entrepreneur, philanthropist, and political and social activist. First self-made female millionaire in the U.S, massive donations to the arts, inspiring millions of African Americans to open their own businesses.	


