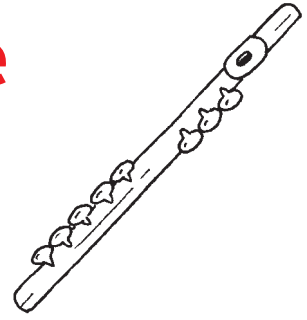
The Magic Flute

Objective:

To assess the children's ability to understand and retell the story.

Activity:

As the children finish reading each section of the story, ask them to retell what they have just read. Then ask them questions about it, noting how well they can deduce, infer and explain their ideas.

Why did the robber tell Jack to take the horse and all the gold?
