




Christ the Sower School Covid-19 Home School Agreement 2020



For the school

We, both as individual staff and as a whole school will take responsibility to:

- Provide a safe and caring environment for pupils, employees and any potential visitors to the school.
- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.
- Contact parents/carers immediately if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19 and request that your child tests for COVID-19 immediately
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' has a confirmed case of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until your test comes back negative
- Provide a curriculum that broadly meets the needs of your child. Learning activities are of a high standard and our staff will support your child to achieve them.
- Provide a curriculum that will include activities based on your child's well-being as well as his/her mental health.
- Continue to demonstrate that every child is valued as an individual
- Provide clear information to parents through regular newsletters, specific letters and notices
- Respond with courtesy and respect
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy and Covid 19 appendix as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement.
- in accordance with our Child Protection Policy, refer any concerns for a child's safety and well-being to the Senior Designated Person for Child Protection, who will notify Social Care, as soon as there is significant concern

For the child

As a pupil at Christ the Sower Ecumenical School I will take responsibility to:

- Do my best with my work
- Be kind and helpful
- Be well behaved and follow CtS behaviour expectations. This is to maintain the safety of myself and others.
- Follow the social distancing rules in class and in the playground
- Move around school as instructed by adults and maintain social distancing rules
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it, bin it, kill it) and avoiding touching your mouth, nose and hands
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser
- Only enter the toilet if there is no one else in there
- Not cough, spit at or sneeze towards others
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated entrance and follow the routines CtS staff have set up
- Use only my equipment and not share my equipment with others
- Not take things home from school;
- Only bring my water bottle, sun hat and waterproof into school from home;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell but only if I really feel unwell –not because I want to go home.
- Let an adult know if I have any worries
- **Understand that if I break any school rules and do not follow the expectations above (especially those designed to keep everyone safe), my parents will be requested to take me home immediately. I will not be able to come back into school until I and everyone else can be safe.**

For the parent/carer

As a parent/carer of a child at Christ the Sower Ecumenical School I/we will take responsibility to:

- Support the school in its efforts to ensure that my child's behaviour and attitude are always appropriate and in the best health and safety interests of all children and staff who are present on site.
- Check for symptoms of COVID-19 each morning (this ought to include a temperature check)
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school. The entire household will get tested and self-isolate until the results are received. I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via telephone
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school **immediately**
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules
- Ensure that my child will only bring a water bottle, a hat and a waterproof (if required)
- Ensure that my child will not bring any other items into school with them or take items home from school
- Remind my child about social distancing rules on a regular basis
- Remind my child about good hand washing and respiratory hygiene.
- Accept that social distancing rules are difficult to follow for children and that some children may not always do this successfully. In those instances the school may ask parents to take their child home on the grounds of health and safety.
- Only enter the school building with a prior pre-arrange appointments and understand that this will be at the school's discretion as social contact between parents and staff is kept to a minimum.
- Support the CtS staff in their efforts to create 'as safe as possible' environment (as per CtS risk assessments) during COVID-19 pandemic.
- Treat all CtS staff with curtesy and respect they deserve.
- Understand that the school is operating in very challenging circumstances and that health and safety of staff and pupils remains the most important factor.
- **I fully understand that if my child is deemed unsafe, they will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe. This is to ensure safety of other pupils as well as staff at CtS.**
