Dear Parents/Carers,

So, this is the night before the big day for some of you! I know I have sent out so many letters over the last few weeks but I wanted to write one last letter before the children come back to school tomorrow.

If your child has any medical needs e.g. an inhaler or hay fever medication, please send it in with your child so that it can be handed directly to a bubble leader. All medications will be kept in the bubble. I know that some of you are concerned about the symptoms of hay fever being mistaken for Covid 19. Please make sure you email the office every time you think your child might be suffering so that we are fully aware. We will continue to monitor your child for any Covid 19 symptoms but if we are in any doubt we will contact you.

I am pretty sure that some children may be disappointed they are not with their class teacher and/or disappointed they are not with particular friends. It would really help them if you could support them positively in this. As you can imagine it was a mammoth task to try and organise 150 children into bubbles while considering all the different needs of those children.

Please remember to bring your signed Home School Agreement with you tomorrow. Don't forget to read it through with your children and support them in signing the agreement as well. If you need to sign a copy at the school gate in the morning you will need to bring a pen with you. This agreement is a very important part of our planning and expectations in helping to keep everyone safe and well.

I hope you found the welcome videos helpful. Sorry Bubble 5 for some reason yours got missed out but I know it is there now. The bubble rooms and bubble leaders are now ready for the children and really looking forward to seeing the children again.

And finally, if you feel you are not ready for your children to return to school please do not worry. Work is still being provided on the school website for your child. If you change your mind at any time please remember new returners can only start on Mondays and we would really appreciate it if you could let the office know beforehand which Monday you are planning to restart them on.

There will be members of staff around the school tomorrow morning and at pick up time to offer you help and support if you should need it. Nothing is too silly or too small to ask – we are all learning and we are all in this together. See you tomorrow.
