Re: Swimming in Year Four Teasel Class

During the Spring Term Teasel Class will be participating in swimming as part of their PE curriculum. The children will be taken swimming by a qualified swimming instructor and members of staff from school.

The lessons will take place at 2.00pm until 2.30pm on a Tuesday at Stantonbury Leisure Centre and they will travel in a designated coach which will leave school at 1.30pm and return by 3.00pm. There will be 11 sessions in total the first session will start on Tuesday 14th January 2020 and the last one will take place on Tuesday 31st March 2020. On completion of the course, each child will be awarded a certificate to celebrate their achievements over the whole swimming programme.

Please ensure your child has the appropriate swimming costume and a towel with them on these days also Stantonbury Sports Centre have requested that all children wear their own swimming hat in lessons and for fire regulations all children are required to have a coat with them in case of evacuation.

There are no costs associated with the lessons as the activity is included in the children's statutory curricular provision. However we do ask for a **voluntary contribution of £11 per child** towards the cost of transport. If you find you cannot afford this, do talk to us because it is possible that you will be able to receive financial support from the Governors Fund.
